TAKE NOTICE THAT pursuant to an Order of the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta granted on March 4, 2011 in Action No. 1003 16069 (the "Order"):

- the Special General Meeting of the Members of the Alberta Taekwondo Association previously scheduled for March 19, 2011 is cancelled;
- a Special General Meeting of the Members of the Alberta Taekwondo Association is now scheduled for **April 9, 2011 at Edmonton, Alberta;**
- the Alberta Taekwondo Association is directed to post on its website the list of the names of members appearing on the **Filed Membership List** (as defined in the Order).

Voting members presently appearing on the 2010-2011 Filed Membership List are entitled to attend and vote at the Special General Meeting on April 9, 2011, provided they are members in good standing on that date.

If your name does not appear on the Filed Membership List, you are not a member of the Alberta Taekwondo Association and will not be permitted to attend and vote at the Special General Meeting on April 9, 2011.

However, you are provided one final opportunity to apply to the Alberta Taekwondo Association to rectify an existing membership application or submit new membership application for the 2010-2011 year in accordance with the criteria and procedures set out below.

If such applications are accepted by the ATA (subject to the advice and directions of the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta), such voting members are also entitled to attend and vote at the Special General Meeting on April 9, 2011, provided they are members in good standing on that date. No further notice of the Special General Meeting on April 9, 2011 will be given to you.

Criteria and Procedure for Applications

In order for an application to rectify an existing application or a new membership application for the 2010-2011 year to be accepted by the Alberta Taekwondo Association, the application must strictly meet all of the following criteria.

- All documents submitted must be clear and legible;
- The applicant must be a member in good standing of a Constituent Do-Jang or an Associate Do-Jang that has been accepted into the Alberta Taekwondo Association and is in good standing with the Alberta Taekwondo Association;

- Contain the applicant's own residential address;
- Contain the applicant's Kukkiwon Certificate showing 1st Dan or greater standing (Kukkiwon Certificate's in progress will not be accepted at this time);
- Application is signed by the applicant and the applicant's Master; and
- Full payment of the applicant's membership fees (with late fee included) by cash or cheque as follows:
 - \$30.00 for a 1-year Individual Black Belt Voting Membership;
 - \$40.00 for a 2-year Individual Black Belt Voting Membership; and
 - \$250.00 for Do-Jang Membership.

(Any cheque submitted which cannot be processed or is rejected for non-sufficient funds will result in a rejected application.)

Any supporting information or documentation must be either sent by email addressed to the ATA Membership Director, Tracy Bonertz in the care of admin@taekwondoalberta.com or received by the ATA office located at 7619 – 104 Street, Edmonton, Alberta, T6E 4C3 (the “ATA Office”) on or before **March 22, 2011**. Any application to rectify existing membership applications and any new membership applications that require the payment of membership fees must be delivered to and received by the ATA Office on or before **March 22, 2011**.

On or before **March 29, 2011**, the ATA will approve or reject applications received on or before March 22, 2011 and post an Updated Membership List (as defined in the Order) listing the names of persons that the ATA considers to be members of the ATA. The ATA may add names to the Updated Membership List pursuant to any advice and directions of the Court given either before or on April 6, 2011.

On **April 7, 2011**, the ATA will post the 2010-2011 ATA Membership List showing the names of persons entitled to attend and vote at the Special General Meeting on April 9, 2011, provided they are members in good standing on that date and present photo identification at the meeting to verify their identity.
