Funding will be granted according to the following guidelines:

- Applicant must be a member in good standing with the ATA
- Applicant shall have worked a minimum of three sanctioned ATA tournaments, including the Alberta Open, within the last year
- There is a perceived benefit to the ATA
- Applicants who have not received funding in the past year will receive priority over those who have received funding
- Referees may not receive more than \$1000.00 in support per fiscal year
- Supporting documentation including event information, cost, travel expenses, and any other relevant information, should be included with the application
- When feasible, applications should be submitted to the referee chair prior to the event for funding to be conditionally approved
- A report and/or sharing of education/experience obtained must be submitted to the referee chairperson no more than two weeks following the event for final approval by the referee committee
